

# ANIMALS IN THE PARK

Work together to create a fun park scene. Each of you will draw different animals and something to go in the park that can be cut out and pasted together to make a park scene.

## Draw an animal.

You can choose any type of animal you like (it could be a SHARK, a GUINEA-PIG or even a WORM!)

- Will your animal wear clothes? If so, what sort?
- Will your animal be fierce or friendly?
- What will your animal be doing in the park?

They could be doing anything from skateboarding to playing tennis, fishing, jogging or sliding down a slide. Silly ideas also welcome!

You might want to do a pencil sketch first.

Use your imagination and draw your best artwork.

## Can you draw something else to go in the park?

You could draw a tree, flowers, a pond, a bench or a bandstand.

Maybe your park could even have a fun fair, an ice-rink or a circus!
