



Make UNIPIGGLE'S CHOCOLATE MUDDY PUDDLES!



You will need:

An adult to help you
A large bar of chocolate (or two)
A heatproof jug or bowl
A medium to large pan
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Oven gloves
A wooden spoon
A large tray with foil or greaseproof paper on it
A Spatula



Step 1 - Break up the chocolate and put it in a heatproof jug or bowl.



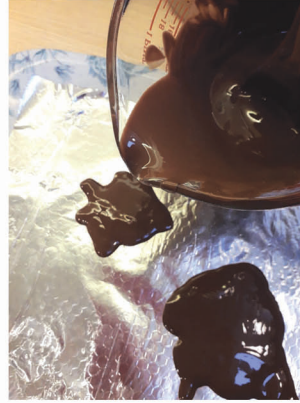
Step 2 - Put this in a pan which is one quarter full of water. (Bowls can rest on top of the pan)



Step 3 - Ask your adult to bring the water to a simmer. (Be careful as this is steamy)



Step 4 - The chocolate will melt, ask your adult to help you stir it.



Step 5 - Once chocolate is fully melted you can turn off the heat. Ask your adult to carefully start pouring chocolate into small puddle shapes on the covered tray.



Step 6 - You can gently shape these to look more like puddles with the wooden spoon. They should be about 6-12 cm diameter and not too thin. (Remember the chocolate is still very hot)



Step 7 - Put the tray of puddles in the fridge to chill. **Step 8** - When chilled use the spatula to gently remove the puddles from the tray.



Step 9 - Your chocolate muddy puddles are now ready to eat or share with family and friends!

Chocolate muddy puddles can be eaten as they are or put on top of your porridge, hot drinks and puds. Keep them chilled in the fridge!

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
